What are your visions for where you want to go? What are the obstacles to go there? How is your faith involved in your visions on where to go? Where do you want to go local, national regional and global?

What part of the climate agenda is closest to your situation to work on? Mitigation? Adaptation? Advocacy for climate finance? Theological awareness rising? Season of Creation actions? Climate Justice agitation? Divestment from fossil fuels?
